Appendix A: Preposition flashcards

<p>Under</p> 	<p>In front of</p> 	<p>In the middle</p> 
<p>On top of</p> 	<p>Behind</p> 	<p>To the left</p> 
<p>Next to</p> 	<p>Between</p> 	<p>To the right</p> 

<p>Touching</p> 	<p>Horizontal</p> 
<p>Parallel to</p> 	<p>Vertical</p> 
<p>At right angles to</p> 	<p>Not touching</p> 

These are just some suggestions of prepositions that students may need to use.

Below are some examples of structures that you could make. The simplest ones, figures 1 and 2, are best for the demonstration phase.

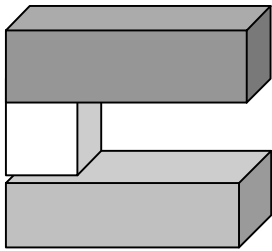

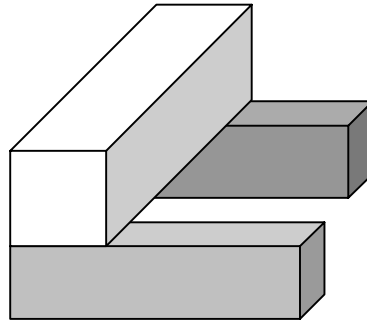

Here are some more complex structures that more able students might like to try. The more complex the structure is, the more challenging the activity becomes.

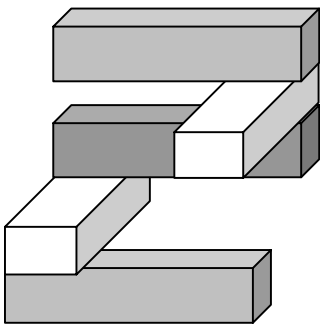

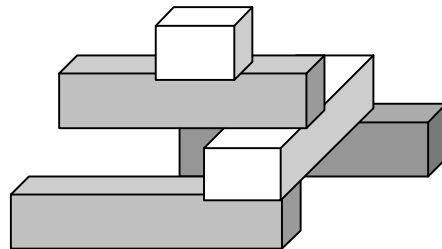
