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Indonesia was chosen for the sixth World Congress on Extensive Reading, and originally scheduled for the summer of 2021 with a venue in Yogyakarta. The global pandemic restrictions on travel and gathering led to a delay of one and then two years, and the congress took place in Denpasar on the island of Bali between 7th and 11th August 2023. This volume has been made possible with the support of the reviewers and proofreaders listed below. I would especially like to thank the proofreaders for allowing me to list them both in alphabetical order and in the number of papers they read!

The Sixth Extensive Reading World Congress was a success with some 300 participants in attendance including over 80 teachers and administrators from Bali itself. The participants enjoyed over 150 presentations and poster sessions during the 3 days of the main event. The main conference was preceded by four 1-hour workshops at Udayana University on August 7th. The participants enjoyed a convivial atmosphere, freely intermingling over the delicious lunches served up by the Denpasar Aston Hotel. The congress was supported by three universities on Bali: Udayana University, Ganesha Pendidikan University and Mahasaraswati University. Financial support was received from the U.S. Embassy Regional English Language Office (RELO).

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
